Materials

- Worsted Weight Yarn (Green, Black, and Orange)
- Size US-G/4.00 mm Crochet Hook
- Needle to sew in ends
- Small amount of stuffing
- Pipecleaner

Abbreviations

- Ss : Slip-stitch
- Sc : Single Crochet
- InvDec : Invisible decrease
- Dec/Inc : Decrease/Increase
- St : Stitch or stitches

Gauge : 5 Rnds and 4 stitches per 1"

Finished piece is about 2"

Worked in the round

Crocheted Pumpkin Miniature Amigurumi







Color Changes

[See video 2]

Note: This pattern requires a lot of color changes. Be sure to check the end of each Rnd before continuing through the round to know when to change colors. Be sure to carry colors required for each round along with you before you need to do a color change.

For color changes with color/color (ex: 1 red/green), pull through the first with the first color (red), and next with the second color (green). [See diagram below]



Main

Ch 2 or use magic hoop method

Rnd 1: Work 6 sc in 2nd ch from hook or into magic hoop (6)

Rnd 2: inc (sc 2) in each st around (12)

Rnd 3: [sc, inc] repeat 6 times (18)

Rnd 4: [sc 2, inc] repeat 6 times (24)

Note: you can keep increasing here for a larger pumpkin

Note: Color changes for making the Jack-O-Lantern version start here, but just ignore the color changes at the end of the Rnd to make a normal pumpkin

Rnd 5: sc in each st (24) [5 orange, 1 black, 4 orange, 1 black, 13 orange]

Rnd 6: sc in each st (24) [5 orange, 2 orange/black, 3 orange, 2 orange/black, 12 orange]

Rnd 7: sc in each st (24) [4 orange, 1 black, 2 black/orange, 4 orange, 2 black/orange, 1 black, 10 orange]

Rnd 8: sc in each st (24) [5 orange, 2 orange/black, 4 black, 3 orange/black, 10 orange]



Continued...

[Continue in all orange]

Rnd 9 and 10: sc in each st (24)

Note: You can continue doing Rnds 9 and 10 to get a longer pumpkin

Add the vine and stem to the top of your piece. For the stem use a pipe cleaner folded in half, stick it in the top of your pumpkin and twist each side to secure, then proceed to wrap green yarn around the pipe cleaner to make a solid stem that matches your vine!

Note: if you increased more after Rnd 4 you'll need to decrease more as well



Rnd 11: [sc 2, invdec] repeat 6 times (18)

Rnd 12: [sc, invdec] repeat 6 times (12)

Rnd 13: dec in each st (6)

Cut, stuff and sew together [See video 4]

Now using a long piece of orange yarn begin threading around from the bottom to the top of your pumpkin 6 times. Pull tight and tie together on the bottom. [See video _]



[All green]

Rnd 1: ch 1, m.p (ch 2, ss into the first ch made),
ch 1, m.p, ch 1, m.p, ch 2

Cut, ch and pull through, leaving a somewhat long
end to sew onto the main ball.
